

October 31st, 2019 Costume Guidelines:

Students are allowed to wear costumes on Thursday, October 31st 2019. However, there are guidelines to follow to make sure the costumes aren't a disruption to the education environment.

Students will not be allowed to wear clown costumes – including masks, wigs, and outfits.

A. Follow the school dress code:

Student's appearance should be neat and clean. Dress and appearance that causes a disruption of the educational process or presents health or safety problems or is gang related shall not be permitted; otherwise, dress and appearance are the responsibility of the student and parents.

B. No masks or face paint

C. No props/costume accessories such as replica weapons, swords, knives, clubs, sticks, pitchforks, bags, wands, blood, gore

Consequences for not following these guidelines:

First Offense: Warning, possible parent/guardian contact; change of clothing may be required to meet dress code standards

Second Offense: Parent/guardian conference, 1 lunch detention, change of clothing may be required to meet dress code standards.

Third Offense: Parent/guardian conference, 2 lunch detentions, change of clothing may be required to meet dress code standards.
