The Department of Foreign Languages at Everett Community College has approved Stanwood High School Instructors to teach Spanish 122 or Spanish 2 and Spanish 123 or Spanish 3. Also, German 122 or German 2 and German 123 or German 2. These courses offer 5 credits towards college. If you are interested in taking this course for college credit, you will need to pay for this class. You are not obligated to take this class for college credit. If you decide not to take it for college credit, you will be given only high school credit. These courses have been formatted to be a college course, and it tends to be more rigorous in order to meet academic expectations from colleges and universities in the United States.

It is important to note that students who take these courses for college credit will NOT have to do any additional work or take extra tests/assessments. All students in these classes will complete the same work.

If you decide to take these courses for college credit at EVCC, please read the following information regarding the requirements for the College in the High School program.

I. These courses qualify for EvCC's College in the High School Program (CHS). Students seeking to earn college credit must enroll in the EvCC CHS program. Program processes and deadlines can be found at www.everettcc.edu/chs.

II. Both German 122-123 and Spanish 122-123 offer 5 credits by completing both semesters at Stanwood High School. Students who only complete one semester will not earn college credit. No partial credit is available.

III. Student eligibility: No changes by the legislature. Only students in grades 10-12 may participate. We continue to advocate for the inclusion of 9th grade students.

IV. Enrollment is a 3-Step process and each step has a deadline. Please check on this attached link to read further information.
