**Scholarship Application**

Applications are open to graduating high school seniors who have volunteered within the Providence organization or in day care facilities, food banks, tutoring, etc. These volunteer activities must involve the health and/or welfare of children. Special consideration will be given to a recipient who is pursuing a degree that encompasses the health and/or welfare of children. Financial need will be considered when awarding these scholarships. Each scholarship that is awarded is in the amount of \$1,500. All scholarships must be used within the first year of high school graduation. All applications must include:

1. At least two letters of recommendation from persons other than a relative. Letters need to be requested at least two weeks before the application is due.
2. One evaluation letter from the applicant's volunteer/community service advisor
3. Official academic transcripts
4. Personal resume

All applications must be computer generated in a 12-point font.

**ON A SEPARATE PIECE OF PAPER, PLEASE RESPOND TO THE FOLLOWING:**

1. **Volunteer Activities/Community Service:** How long have you participated in volunteer activities over a one year period March 29, 2023 – March 29, 2024 (minimum of 75 hours volunteer activities required). Again, these volunteer activities must involve the health and/or welfare of children. How many hours have you accumulated?
2. **Extracurricular Activities:** Submit any activities in which you have been involved outside of class and explain how these activities have contributed to your personal and/or professional growth (i.e. athletics, clubs, hobbies, etc.).
3. **Personal Achievement:** List any awards, honors and/or personal achievements that mean the most to you. (100 words or less)
4. **Personal Goals:** What are your career goals, and what is your action plan in achieving these goals? Financial need (free or reduced lunch, for example) is one of the considerations for the scholarships. If you or your immediate family has encountered financial hardships, include how that is affecting your future educational plans. (100 words or less)

#### **ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP**

Each scholarship recipient will be awarded a \$1,500 college scholarship to be used within the first school year following high school graduation.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Graduating seniors must have participated in volunteer activities over a one-year period from March 29, 2023-March 29, 2024 with a minimum of 75 hours. Volunteer activities must involve the health and/or welfare of children.

Special consideration will be given to a graduate entering the health care field.

Financial need will be considered.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

- \* At least two letters of recommendation from persons other than a relative. Letters need to be requested at least two weeks before the application is due.
- \* One evaluation letter from the applicant's volunteer/community service advisor
- \* Official academic transcripts
- \* Personal resume
